

LCAA Winter Class Schedule – January - March 2021

Painting

Watercolor with Karen Frattali

Tuesday, 11am – 2 pm, Jan. 12 – March 2, \$180/ \$190

This class will focus on mentoring each student individually, and help to guide them in developing their painting process. Students will bring their own photo references (original images taken by the student, not images from the internet.) Fundamentals will be shared such as pigment choice, composition, brush work, etc. Projects can be worked on in class and at home. Questions and critiquing part of the session. All Skill Levels, adult. Supply list available.

Landscape Painting Plus - (oil, acrylic) – Carol Herr

Friday, 10am-12pm, Feb. 5 – March 12 \$90 / \$100

This class for oil or acrylic painters will focus on landscape, however students may work on other subjects if they wish. Composition, perspective and color mixing will be addressed. Traditional techniques including using an under-painting to enhance your work will be taught. Students will work on their own individual paintings with help from the instructor.

All skill levels, adult. A materials list is available. Bring a photo to work from, borrow one from the instructor.

Passion for Pastels – Dot Stepenaski

Thursday, 9am-12pm, March 4 – April 8, \$135 / \$145

With interest in pastels, there are new colors and surfaces to work on. We will work with color as value. When you have a solid understanding of value, you can paint any subject, landscape, portrait or still life. Students who are new will work on exercises - how to handle pastels, value and build colors, then work on a painting. Those with more experience will be challenged according to their skill level. Focus is on personal growth. All skill levels. Adult. Students should contact the instructor to review the supplies they currently have.

Drawing

Pen & Ink – Tony Bonazzi

Monday, 7-9pm, Feb. 8 – March 15, \$90 / \$100

Drawing in pen & ink has different rules than drawing in pencil, by using different types of lines to create values. The first classes will focus on techniques and the remainder on drawing.

Beginner, Intermediate skill levels, Adult. Materials Needed: Bristol paper pad (9x12), pens (no sharpies, ball point, brush pens or markers – either a nib holder and nibs or technical pens such as Micron.) bottle of ink, pencil, eraser. Photo reference.

One & Two Point Perspective – Tony Bonazzi

Saturday, 9am-4pm, March 6 (one day workshop), \$55 / \$60

Are you having trouble showing depth in your paintings or drawings, or with depicting buildings, roads, arches, etc.? Students will practice drawing these subjects, to correctly use perspective to improve their work.

Beginner skill level, Adult. Materials Needed: Drawing pad, pencil, eraser, ruler or straight edge 2 ft. long. Bring a packed lunch.

Drawing for the Painter – Carol Herr

Thursday, 4:30-6pm, March 4 – 25, \$45 / \$50

Drawing is an important part of painting and having good drawing skills will enhance your paintings. This class will emphasize the basics, including value, shape, line, texture, composition and figure ground relationships. We will do exercises to improve your skills and work on preliminary drawings and studies that will enhance your future paintings. Beginner, Intermediate skill levels, Adult. Materials needed: Sketchbook (9x12 or 11x14), Drawing Pencils (2H, HB, 2B), Eraser, Ruler.

DUE TO THE PANDEMIC WE HAVE MADE THE FOLLOWING CHANGES –

We are limiting the size of our classes to a maximum of 8 students per class. Students will be spaced at least 6 ft. apart and we will be using the gallery in addition to the classroom to maintain social distancing. Please sign up early to be assured a spot.

Instructor & students must wear masks at all times.

We are cleaning frequently and tables, easels and touchable surfaces will be cleaned before and after class. Hand sanitizer is available and frequent hand washing is encouraged.

Payment for class fee is due upon registration, at least one week in advance of starting date. The LCAA charges a \$35 fee for all returned checks. Classes may be cancelled if minimum enrollment of 5 students is not reached & payment returned to student. Classes may be cancelled or rescheduled due to inclement weather. The instructor will contact students about changes to the schedule. Students are responsible for purchase of supplies needed for class unless provided by the instructor.

Withdrawal – before class begins, a \$10 fee is charged, but the remainder of the fee will be returned. After the first class, a reimbursement of 50% of tuition will be returned. There is no reimbursement for other missed classes. Student must contact the LCAA office about withdrawal from class in a timely manner.

Note: Students under the age of 18 cannot take adult classes unless it is specified as accepting children or teens in the class description. In addition, ages for those 18 and younger must be provided on this form.
