LANDSCAPE PAINTING CLASS

These classes are for oil or acrylic painters, the following colors are suggested-

PAINTS

White - Permalba (oil) or Titanium (large tube)
Burnt Umber

Cadmium Yellow Medium
Cadmium Red Light
Alizeron Crimson
Permanent Green Light
Thalo Green
Cerulean Blue Hue
Ultramarine Blue Deep

(*Optional Colors)

*Cadmium Yellow Orange
Yellow Ochre *Cadmium Orange
*Cobalt Violet
*Magenta
*Thalo Red Rose
*Burnt Sienna
*Cadmium Red Medium
*Cobalt blue
*Cadmium Yellow Light

*Medium - For Oils - Res-n-gel (made by Weber) For Acrylics - you may use one of the mediums to slow down drying time if you wish.

Brushes - I recommend bristle brushes- filberts or flats, long handled, an assortment small - bigger.#0, #1, #2 or #3, .

A few small sable rounds are good for detail work #00, #0, #1 or #2.

Solvent - Oil painters must use odorless turpentine such as Turpenoid. Glass jar to put your solvent in.

Acrylic Painters - Container for water, may use an acrylic medium to slow down drying time.

Palette- The easiest is to use the disposable paper palettes, they come in various sizes. You may use a regular palette if you choose.

Palette knife for mixing paints

Rags (lint-free), oil painters should bring a bag.(you must take any rags with solvent or paint with you, the LCAA is not allowed to have them placed in the trash because they are flammable)

Drawing paper or small sketch book ,drawing pencils & eraser

Canvas - Pre- stretched canvas. If you are a beginner, I recommend not going any larger than 18x24.

If you already have paints and have colors close to those suggested you can use them instead of buying new paints. The optional colors are nice to have but if you have a budget you can do O.K. with the basic colors. Please use tube oil or acrylic colors, not bottles of craft paint. I recommend Grumbacher or Winsor Newton if you are buying colors.
