### **Dan Graziano Workshop – Suggest Rather Than Render**

Friday & Saturday, 9am-4pm, Feb. 21 & 22, \$265 Members/\$275 Non-Members

This two-day studio workshop will focus on painting “alla prima” (all at once) as well as developing greater skills of observation, simplification and quickly painting “wet on wet” to create strong “painterly” paintings. The workshop will also discuss techniques to quickly transfer the important elements of your reference to the canvas, creating an artistic painting rather than simply rendering every detail from a reference.

The first morning of the workshop begins with a discussion of oil painting basics (from materials to paint handling) and will also address the fundamentals of color, value, edges, perspective and other “practical” elements related to successful painting. Participants will then work on a series of timed painting exercises incorporating the techniques discussed and developing their skills of observation, simplification and quickly working in an “alla prima” manner.

Each day of the workshop will include a short painting demo by Dan with explanation of his process along the way and plenty of one-on-one individual instruction throughout the day.

This workshop is designed for intermediate to advanced painters in both oil and acrylic mediums, however proficiency in basic drawing is required. Participants are encouraged to bring photos to paint from or may choose from photos brought by the instructor.

**CLASS SIZE IS LIMITED SO REGISTER SOON.** Adult Class. Participants supply their own art supplies and equipment (easels are provided). A suggested supply list will be provided at registration.

### **Dot Stepenaski - Passion for Pastels**

Thursdays 9am -12pm, Feb.20 – March 27, \$140 Members/\$150 Non-members

With interest in pastels, there are new colors and surfaces to work on. We work with color as value. With a solid understanding of value, you can paint any subject, landscape, portrait, or still life. New students work on exercises such as how to handle pastels, value, and color building. More experienced students will be challenged based on their skill level. Focus is on personal growth. This is an all skill level adult class. Contact the instructor to review supplies.

### **Carol Herr – Landscape Painting Plus (oil or acrylic)**

Saturdays 10am-12:30pm, Jan. 18 – Feb. 15, \$100 Members/\$110 Non-members

This class will focus on landscape, however students may also work on other subjects.

Composition, perspective and color mixing will be addressed. Traditional techniques including using an under-painting to enhance your work will be taught. Students will work on their own individual paintings with help from the instructor.

All skill levels, adult. A materials list is available. Bring a photo to work from, or borrow one from the instructor.

### **Tony Bonazzi – Watercolor for Beginners**

Thursdays 7pm - 9pm, Feb. 6 – March 13, \$95 Members/\$105 Non-members

In this class students will learn the properties of handling watercolor. The first 3 weeks will focus on techniques and the last 3 weeks the student will do a painting of their choice. Come to learn and have fun. This is a beginner class for adults. Supplies needed: Transparent watercolor paints, masking tape, brushes (#4, #8, #10 rounds, ¾ flat wash), palette, water container, watercolor pad (9x12”).

**Carol Herr – Drawing - Problem Solving Preliminaries**

Friday 10am - 12pm, Jan. 24 & 31, \$40 Members/\$45 Non-members

Have you realized after working on a painting for weeks that your composition is boring, your perspective isn't quite right, and your proportions are off? Taking the time to plan out your painting with preliminaries such as roughs, thumb nails, and studies will improve your final work. For beginners and intermediates. Adults. Bring drawing pencils (2H, HB, 2B, 4B), eraser, sketchbook with drawing paper.

**Tony Bonazzi – Pen & Ink**

Tuesday, 7-9pm, Feb. 4 – March 11, \$95 Members/ \$105 Non-members

In this class the beginner student will learn different techniques of cross hatching and how to draw in ink. For the intermediate, students will draw and become more proficient in the medium. Adults. Beginner & Intermediate. Supplies Needed: Nibs and ink bottle or micron set of pens, Bristol pad 9x12", pencil and eraser.

**Carol Herr – Drawing - Portrait Primer**

Thurs. 4-6pm, March 13, 20, 27, \$50 Members / \$55 Non-Members

Portraits can be one of the most difficult subjects to master. This class will get you started with the basics and give you tips on creating a likeness. Beginner & Intermediate. Adults. Supplies Needed: Drawing pencils (2H, HB, 2B, 4B), eraser, 11x14" good drawing paper (Vellum Bristol preferred).
